Description of Parent Program Improvement Plan

In order to insure higher numbers of parents participating in Learning Beyond the Bell (LBB), staff development and supervision will focus on improving cooperation between after-school and school day staff. Site Coordinators will be required to volunteer and assist in PTA and other campus based parent events. Learning Beyond the Bell parent/student programs have been planned for the year to include 3 fall and 3 spring events. Parent participation in campus parent events is being documented to insure that we are reporting all parental participation at LBB campuses.

Parent events are being advertised through district website, local newspapers, flyers sent home with students, campus PTA Newsletter, and direct contact with parents through home visits by the Case Managers.

Parent/Child family literacy classes are being offered this fall in partnership with KERA and our district Bilingual Department. Fall classes are once a week for three weeks. Reading skills and family activities are planned for each class with each child receiving a donated book.
